

# HOYA TOP 10 – Jr Program

Welcome to the Hoya Football Program. We are excited about our upcoming spring season – from 6<sup>th</sup> grade up to Varsity!

Below is a list of the Top 10 FAQ's. By providing this information, we hope to help you stay better informed about our program.

1. Where to find information during the season:

2. How is information communicated to players/parents during the season?
  - a. First line of communication is from Team Mom (see below) to parents via email. **PLEASE PROVIDE YOUR TEAM MOM WITH AT LEAST ONE EMAIL ADDRESS THAT IS CHECKED DAILY.**
  - b. Second line is via newsletter from the booster club. This info is generally for all ages/teams/parents and includes “happenings”, weekly updates, etc and is sent out at least weekly.
  - c. You can always check the website for any updates
3. When/where are practices/games?
  - a. Generally the Jr Program practices M, T, TH 6:30-8:30pm at Harrison. This may change on the Thursdays we have home Fresh/JV games – this will be determined by your coaching staff.
  - b. Games on Saturdays – check the website for times/locations
  - c. Season ends the last week of October, with playoffs after that.
4. What is my involvement with the High School Program?
  - a. We treat the entire program as one program; therefore, as Jr. Program parents, you will be included/invited in most everything the booster club does. You will be required to work concessions just as the HS parents are. You are invited to all booster club meetings and events – and we really want our Jr Program parents to be involved!!
5. How can I get tickets to the Thurs/Fri night games?
  - a. We have Season Tickets on sale (reserved seating) – see the Ticket Package forms. You can also purchase single game tickets either at the ticket booth the day of the game or (for Friday Home games) at Harrison during lunch the day of the game (recommended!!). If you work concessions for a Thurs/Fri night game, you will be required to purchase a ticket to get in (gate money does not come to the booster club). Obviously if you work on a Sat, you will purchase a ticket to watch your son's game.
6. How can I get my registration paid for?
  - a. We have a wonderful sponsorship program in place. For every \$1500 you bring in as sponsorship (see forms) you will get one player registration (\$395) paid.

7. What is the Hoya Room?
  - a. The Hoya Room is a benefit for our season ticket holders and sponsors (at specified levels) – think of it like a “club room”. It is located on the top floor of the Field House – complete with food and a great view of the game! You must have a pass to enter; no unattended children will be admitted.
